

UNIVERSITY OF CONNECTICUT PEDIATRIC RESIDENCY PROGRAM
Policy on Eligibility of Pediatric Residents

In order to be eligible to be a pediatric resident in the University of Connecticut program, applicants must be one of the following:

1. Graduate of medical schools in the United States or Canada accredited by the LCME.
2. Graduate of colleges of osteopathic medicine in the United States accredited by the AOA.
3. Graduate of medical schools outside of the United States and Canada who meet one of the following qualifications:
 - a. Have received a currently valid certificate from the ECFMG prior to appointment or
 - b. Have a full unrestricted license to practice medicine in Connecticut.
4. Graduate of medical schools outside of the United States who have completed a “Fifth Pathway” program provided by an LCME-accredited medical school

In order to be a Pediatric resident in the University of Connecticut program, prospective residents identified through the NRMP match or outside of the match process for non-United States seniors who are accepted off cycle or transferring to the program:

1. All of the forms and information required by the Office of Graduate Medical Education of the University Of Connecticut School Of Medicine must be completed accurately.
2. All required orientation and compliance requirements for the School of Medicine and the institutions in which the training is conducted, must be properly completed.
